CURRENT OPERATING WORK

Frontier exosome biologics. Wharton’s jelly mesenchymal stem cell–derived exosome biologics on the FDA 351(a) BLA regulatory pathway. Program structured for IND-enabling work under 21 CFR 1271 and 21 CFR 312, with CMC, preclinical, and clinical components organized for CBER review.

Investigational oncology. Targeted Osmotic Lysis cancer therapy program. Investigational use, evidence-based protocol design under FDA oncology pathway.

Interventional procedure operations. Operational support for the Discseel Procedure for chronic low-back pain (annular tear sealing with fibrin), and adjunctive regenerative protocols.

Medical-legal services. Personal-injury case-management support: provider scheduling, letter-of-protection administration, and case-to-settlement coordination for plaintiff counsel.
